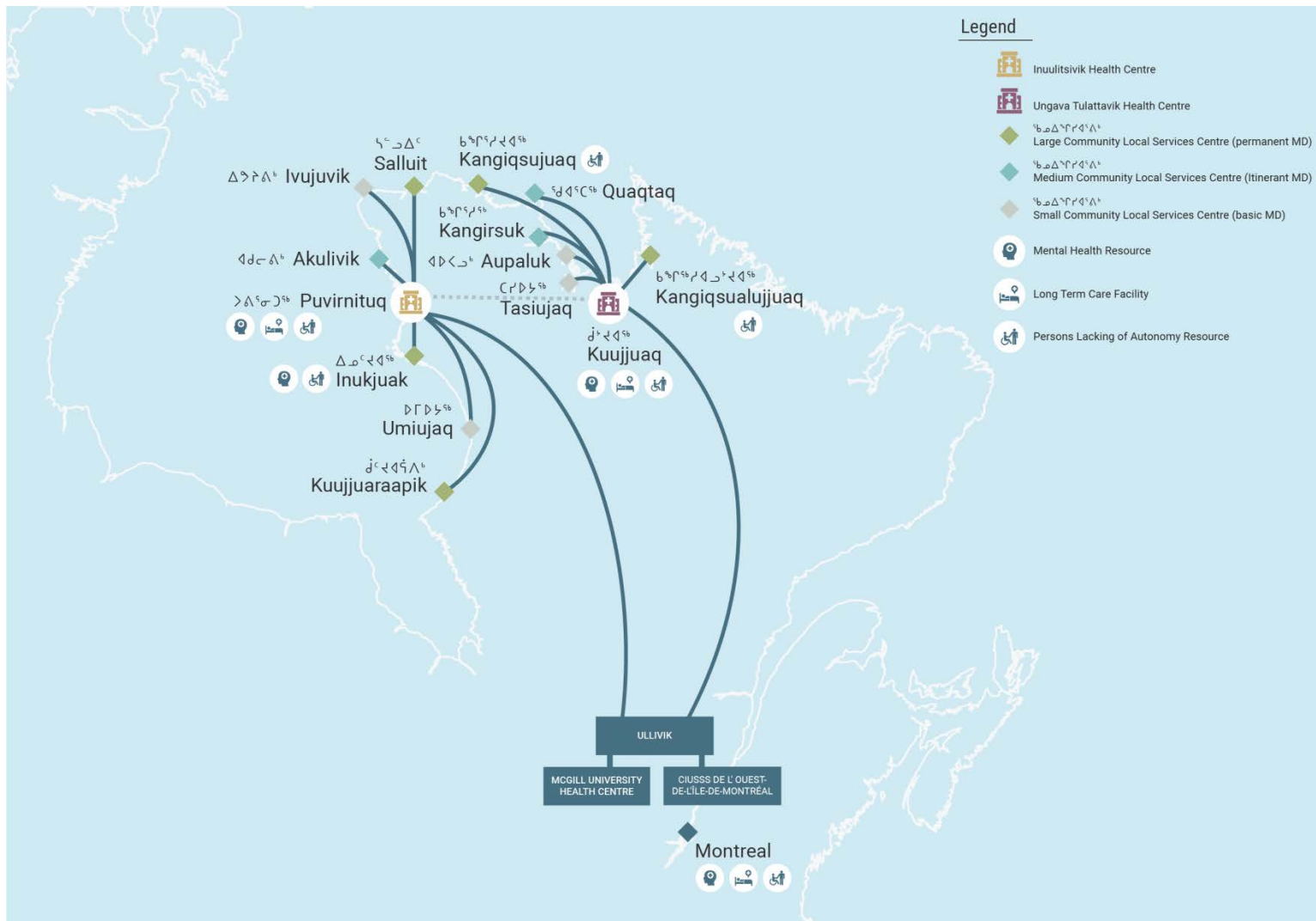


Figure 1. Nunavik Ungava-Hudson: Inuit Communities in Quebec

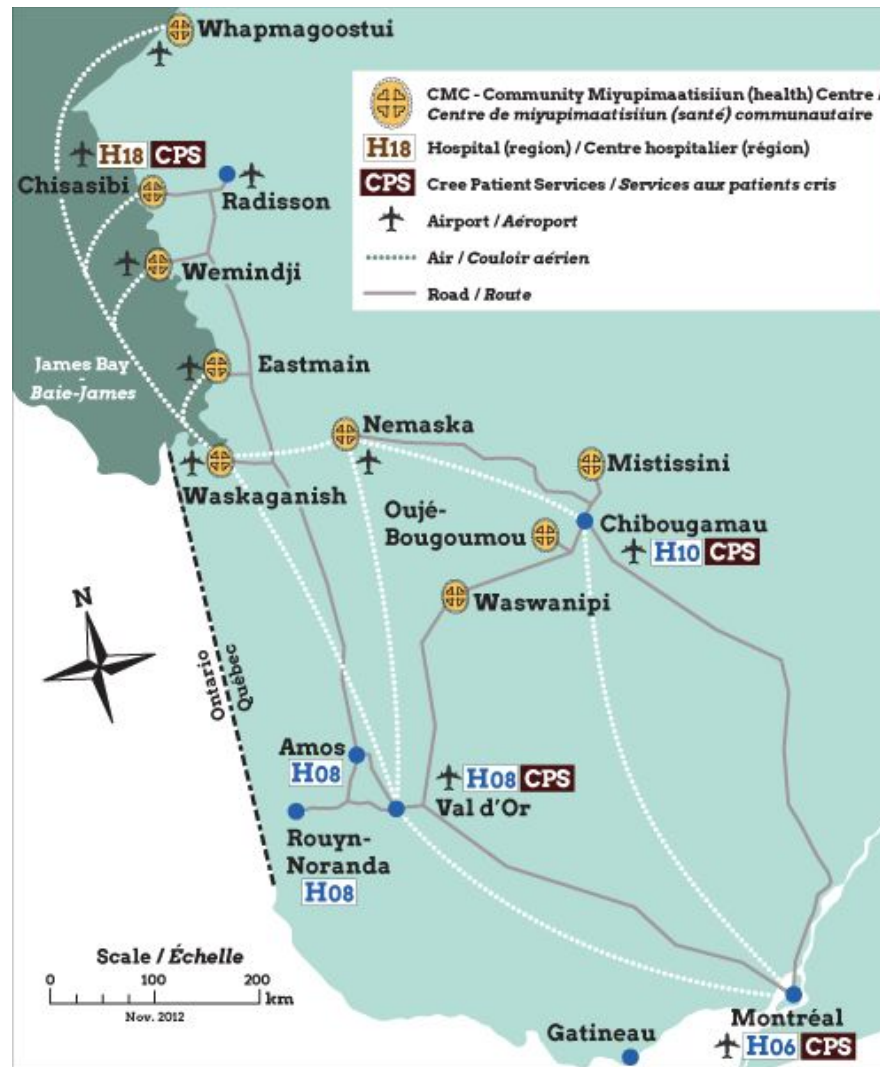


Figure 2. Cree Communities in Quebec
